Our Egypt Field Hockey program has seen a large increase in numbers this year! We are thrilled to expand our program from one team to three in just our second year! We are also hosting our first annual play day at the park on Saturday, October 15th! We will have several teams participating, indoor vendors, and snack stand available all day from 8:00AM-4:00PM. All are welcome for a great day of hockey!

We still have openings for any girls in grades K-2 who want to sign up at Hitter's Edge, Whitehall for the instructional field hockey program on Sunday's from 5:00-6:00PM. The first practice is Sunday, September 11th and you can sign up that night at Hitter's Edge or contact Michele Laubach at michelelaubach@hotmail.com. The schedule will be given that night and the instructional team is also involved with Egypt park play day and games.

Egypt will have a grade 3/4 team and a 5/6 grade team. We will play games with local teams and participate in four play days including our own. We are working on the develop of skills and game rules while participating in game and tournament play.
