



CODE OF CONDUCT

The Egypt Memorial Park has adopted the following code of conduct that shall pertain to ANY activity associated with the organization. These shall include, but are not limited to: Baseball, Softball, Field Hockey, special events, etc. The code applies to **ALL** players, coaches, parents, guardians, family members and volunteers.

The Park association will enforce a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for inappropriate and unacceptable conduct, including but not limited to:

- The use of foul language
- Threatening verbal or physical behavior
- Threatening or derogatory statements posted to any social media site
- Unpartisan-like conduct that results in actions, which are detrimental to the individuals or the public welfare or are not consistent with the general guidelines of the league or group
- Use of tobacco and tobacco like products on or near the fields

Failure to comply with this code of conduct will result in penalties including ejection from the game or event and possible suspension from future games or events.

Infractions will be addressed in this order:

1. Head Coach/Director of event
2. Sport Committee Director
3. Athletic Director
4. Park President
5. Park Board of Directors

Players are reminded that when in uniform they represent the organization and must ACT appropriately.
