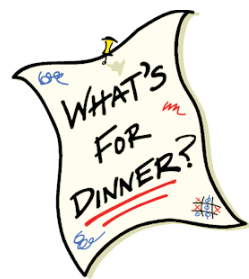
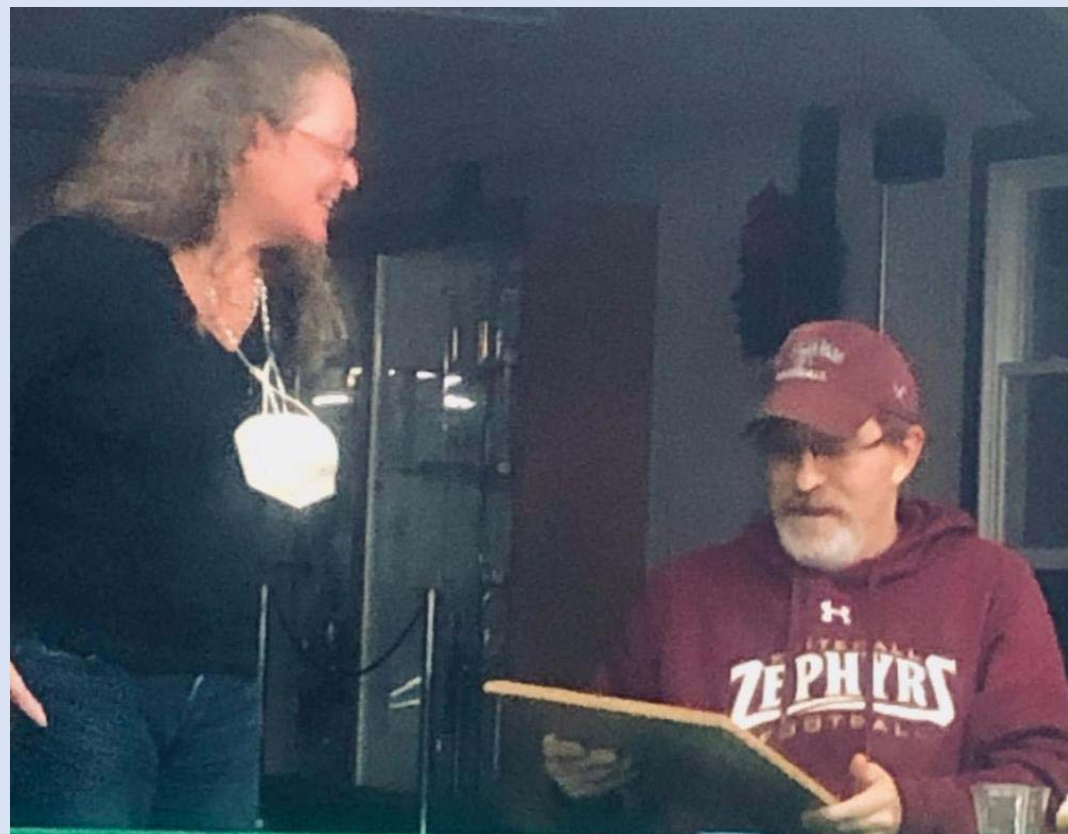
EMP Festival
